Best practices


To stop in time, **keep a safe distance** behind the vehicle ahead of you:

> At least 3 seconds for heavy vehicles,> At least 2 seconds for light vehicles. Always adjust your speed to grades, turns, traffic circles and other road configurations, as well as traffic conditions and vehicle load.



Commitments

Don't exceed the speed limits set by TotalEnergies for the vehicle type (they may be lower than the local limits).



-The heavier the vehicle, the greater **the braking distance**.

- Braking distance doubles on wet roads.
